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CURRENT SITUATION

Wade Walker Park netball and tennis players are extremely active but lack a covered area that would allow us to host teams or have a true rest area for players and guests.

A pavilion would much needed shade and protection from inclement weather as well as encourage folks to picnic, watch, and perhaps participate in either sport. All of which serve to increase foot traffic, community building and potential revenue (through organized day time leagues), that can help mitigate the cost of upkeep for both the netball and tennis courts. PROPOSED PROJECT

Install a 36 FT pavilion. A path from the sidewalk will lead to the prefabricated hexagon pavilion, a design currently used by DeKalb County Parks and Recreation, and will sit in the center of the open area directly between the tennis courts and just up the stairs from the netball court. This allows both netball and tennis players to easily view games on both courts. Picnic tables will be placed on the floor of the pavilion. 3 sturdy permanent garbage cans will flank the pavilion to encourage proper disposal of trash and keep the area clean. (See Figure 3)
