RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA, TO ACCEPT THE DEPARTMENT OF WATERSHED MANAGEMENT'S 2025 to 2034 (CIP 2024) CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN.

- **WHEREAS**, the Governing Authority of DeKalb County (County) is charged with protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County; and
- **WHEREAS,** Article 9, Section 2, Paragraph 3 of the Constitution of the State of Georgia confers upon the Governing Authority of the County the power to provide water and sewer services; and
- **WHEREAS**, the County Department of Watershed Management (DWM) has developed and has implemented, for the purposes of planning, computer-based hydraulic models of the County's water distribution and wastewater collection systems that allow unprecedented understanding of the County's water and wastewater systems; and
- **WHEREAS,** the DWM developed the County's comprehensive Water and Wastewater Master Plans through 2050 that use responsible long-term planning processes for the identification and definition of needed capital improvement projects; and
- **WHEREAS,** DWM developed, documented and implemented a multi-criteria, teambased and data-driven CIP Prioritization Process tool to identify the projects most critical to the maintenance and development of the County's water and wastewater systems; and
- **WHEREAS,** DeKalb County's Capital Improvement Plan for water and sewer services (CIP 2021) was previously accepted by the Governing Authority of DeKalb County on February 23, 2021; and
- **WHEREAS,** DWM has updated the list of projects required since the approval of CIP 2021 using the aforementioned CIP Prioritization Process tool to identify the current projects most critical to the maintenance and development of the County's water and wastewater systems; and
- **WHEREAS,** the County is under a Consent Decree (CD) mandating that numerous deficiencies in the wastewater collection system must be addressed; and
- **WHEREAS,** DWM advises that it is necessary for the County to make improvements to the water and wastewater systems to allow for continued growth; and
- **WHEREAS,** DWM advises that the projects set forth in the Capital Improvement Plan for the years 2025 through 2034 (CIP 2024) are necessary to maintain, improve, and upgrade the County's water and wastewater systems (see Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference); and

WHEREAS, the projects reflected in CIP 2024 are not listed in the order of the priority of the projects and the cost estimates may be revised over the life of the plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Governing Authority of DeKalb County, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of same, that Exhibit A is hereby accepted as the DeKalb County Capital Improvement Plan for water and sewer services for the period 2025-2034.
