#### RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION IN OBSERVATION OF CONSTITUTION DAY IN DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA AND HONORING THE FORMATION AND SIGNING OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTIONIN ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1787 AND CELEBRATING THE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITES OF CITIZENSHIP

- **WHEREAS**, on September  $17^{th}$  of every year DeKalb County is committed to acknowledge and celebrate Constitution Day including Citizenship Day as part of Constitution Week, which is celebrated between September  $17^{th} 23^{rd}$ ; and
- **WHEREAS**, the commemoration honors the signing of the United States Constitution, on September 17, 1787, where the thirty-nine courageous Founding Fathers signed the most influential document in American history and formed the inalienable rights of American citizenship; and
- WHEREAS, the Constitution, along with the Bill of Rights, established the framework of our government and the rights and freedoms that form the foundational principals of the United States; and
- **WHEREAS**, every American shares in this legacy of a never-ending pursuit and defense of liberty; and
- WHEREAS, citizenship inherently includes the responsibility to respect and defend the vision of our Founding Fathers as well as participate in the ever evolving and unfolding story of freedom; and
- **WHEREAS**, the United States Constitution stands as a testament to the tenacity of Americans throughout history to pursue their liberties, freedoms and inalienable rights; and
- **WHEREAS**, Constitution Day each year serves as a solemn reminder of the privileges and responsibilities of United States citizenship
- WHEREAS, this day has traditionally given others the opportunity to learn about the Constitution, its history, and its role in shaping American society; and
- WHEREAS, each year DeKalb celebrates Constitution Week by celebrating the connection between the Constitution and Citizenship, reflecting on what it means to be a citizen of the United States, including those who are Americans by choice; and
- **WHEREAS**, for 238 years, the Constitution has served as the supreme law of the land and not only establishes the rule of law, but also creates the framework for an immigration system that enables immigrants to become citizens; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the DeKalb County Governing Authority, declares, honors, and commemorates the signing of the United States Constitution and the privileges and freedoms of American Citizens; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Governing Authority urges all people of DeKalb County, Georgia to pause on September 17<sup>th</sup>, to acknowledge the anniversary of the signing of the Untied States Constitution, dated 1787, which is the foundation of the entire government and legal system and marks the freedoms and rights that the United States strives to provide to all citizens today; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that we, the Governing Authority, on behalf of all citizens of DeKalb County, Georgia, pledge to continue the never-ending pursuit of all of the freedoms memorialized in the United States Constitution, including liberty and justice for all.
