Justification:

The Department of Watershed Management (DWM) is recommending to award contracts to two vendors for both Sections 1 and 2 of this solicitation to perform the specified scope of work with a contract term of 3 Years w/1 year option.

Section 1:

- 1. The Renee Group, Inc. Total recommended contract value of \$8,916,450 is based on a total bid price of \$17,832,900 divided by 2 which adjusts the quantities to half of the estimated bid tab quantities.
- 2. Inland Pipe Rehabilitation (IPR) Total recommended contract value of \$9,482,351.25 is based on a total bid price of \$18,964,702.50 divided by 2 which adjusts the quantities to half of the estimated bid tab quantities.

Section 2:

- 1. Kemi Construction, Inc. Total recommended contract value of \$21,359,252.50 is based on a total bid price of \$42,718,505 divided by 2 which adjusts the quantities to half of the estimated bid tab quantities.
- 2. The Renee Group, Inc. Total recommended contract value of \$21,545,305.70 is based on a total bid price of \$43,090,611.40 divided by 2 which adjusts the quantities to half of the estimated bid tab quantities.

The award to multiple vendors is required in order to meet the demands of the Consent Decree PASARP rehabilitation work currently underway. The primary emphasis of the contract will be to address the critical 14 sanitary sewer overflow areas. DWM recommendation herein is based on the administrative reviews including verifying references, cost evaluation, providing history of similar projects, and overall qualifications of the company.
