

Price Analysis

Agent reviewed price quote received from CBA Sports dated 4/18/2017 for the N.H. Scott recreation center that had the costs of a Full Basketball Court quoted at \$142,063.59.

In doing research for this cost analysis, multiple sites (billry.com, homeadvisor.com) listed the costs from \$11,000 to \$76,000, depending upon a number of factors.

According to homeadvisor.com, costs to install Full Regulation Courts show:

In tabulation of the costs specific to this bid, the following costs are specific to get the site prepped, concrete poured, striping and coating costs \$83,782.00. This does not include costs for the removal and replacement of site amenities.

Shoal Creek II (2 courts): \$83,782.00 – average cost \$41,891.00

Glen Emerald (2 courts): \$61,681.00 – average cost: \$30,840.50

Bouldercrest (1 court): \$40,280.00

Shoal Creek I (2 courts): \$62,048.00 – average cost: \$31,024.00

Pricing just for the basketball courts do fall in line with the national average range.
