RESOLUTION ADOPTING DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA URBAN REDEVELOPMENT PLAN – 4380 MEMORIAL DRIVE

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 61 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, entitled the "Urban Redevelopment Law," as amended (the "Urban Redevelopment Law"), the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County, Georgia (the "County") held a public hearing on May 13, 2025, on a proposed urban redevelopment plan entitled "DeKalb County, Georgia Urban Redevelopment Plan 4380 Memorial Drive" (the "Urban Redevelopment Plan"), a copy of which is on file with the County; and
- WHEREAS, public notice of such public hearing was published in the <u>Atlanta Journal-Constitution</u>, a newspaper having a general circulation in the area of operation of the County, on May 2025, and proof of such publication is on file with the County; and
- **WHEREAS**, the County has prepared and adopted a general plan for the physical development of the County as a whole (the "General Plan"); and
- WHEREAS, no families will be displaced from the urban redevelopment area described in the Urban Redevelopment Plan, and therefore no method for relocation of such families need be provided; and
 - WHEREAS, the Urban Redevelopment Plan conforms to the General Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Urban Redevelopment Plan will afford maximum opportunity, consistent with the sound needs of the County as a whole, for the rehabilitation or redevelopment of the urban redevelopment area described in the Urban Redevelopment Plan by private enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Urban Redevelopment Plan constitutes an appropriate part of the County's workable program for utilizing appropriate private and public resources to eliminate and prevent the development or spread of pockets of blight, to encourage needed urban rehabilitation, and to provide for the redevelopment of pockets of blight, all as set forth in the Urban Redevelopment Law; and
- WHEREAS, after careful study and investigation, the County desires to approve the Urban Redevelopment Plan;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County and the Chief Executive Officer of the County, that all statements, findings, and recitations set forth in the above and foregoing preambles are hereby determined and declared to be true and correct.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Urban Redevelopment Plan and the urban redevelopment project set forth therein are hereby approved.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that any and all resolutions in conflict with this resolution be and the same are hereby repealed.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of the County and approval by the Chief Executive Officer of the County.
