### Leadership Academy London Experience Overview

In support of 100 BMOD International Cultural Research Program, the chapter is offering an opportunity for students of the Leadership Academy to travel abroad to London. The experience will be a rich opportunity steeped in history, multi-culturalism, and geography. Students will experience the trip with their peers in the Leadership Academy and the students of the 100 Black Men of London mentor program through a partnership with the London Chapter and their local leadership team. This collaboration will allow students from both chapters to immerse in each other's culture which will showcase their differences and similarities.

### Leadership Academy London Experience Activities/Events may include:

- River Thames History and Sightseeing Cruise
- Guided walking tours of London
- Community Investment Project with local charity to prep and serve meals at soup kitchen
- Meet and greet at American Embassy with Foreign Service Officers (FSOs)
- Visit black and mixed-raced historic sites from the 18<sup>th</sup> century and other historic periods
- Balck students of Cambridge and Oxford will give a guided tour
- Visit of historic sites including Big Ben, Windsor Palace, London Bridge, Trafalgar Square, and other sites
- One-day trip to Paris to include big bus tours of historic Paris sites, guided walking tours and multiple cuisine experiences

### Selected Student Requirement Highlights:

- Active member in Leadership Academy
- High School Student currently in 8<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> grade
- A minimum grade point average of 2.0
- Complete 20 hours of community service by specific deadline
- Submit a one-page 300 words essay as their interest letter
