#### Clarkston

• <u>Call for Artists RFQ:</u> Living Walls will work with Clarkston City officials and stakeholders to create an RFQ application.

 Mockup Phase: Clarkston city officials and stakeholders will choose the finalists and Living Walls will guide each finalist in creating mockups. Clarkston City officials and stakeholders will present the top two designs to the community for a final vote.

## **Pre- Production**

- <u>Clarkston City officials/ Dekalb County:</u> Will handle the renewal of the underpass lighting, lane Closures, Permits, Wayfinding Signage, and Site preparation (Wall cleaning, Priming)
- <u>Living Walls will handle:</u> The timeline + coordination for lane closures, and guidance for materials needed.

#### Production

- Living Walls will handle all production during the installation of the mural.
- Coordinate with the city to ensure proper safety measures + Timing
- We will seal the wall with a non-sacrificial (permanent) anti-graffiti coating
