DeKalb County Innovation and Technology Department is requesting Purchasing and Contracting's assistance in preparing a BOC agenda item with SHI International.

The SIEM (Insight IDR) will serve as a system of record (SOR) that will provide forensic log data that can be used for root cause analysis (RCA) in the case of a cyber event. This platform is critical, as the COVID-19 pandemic has magnified cybersecurity challenges that DeKalb County is faced with. This solution will speed along the investigation and remediation process when an incident occurs. InsightVM provides a fully available, scalable, and efficient way to collect vulnerability data, provides answers to DoIT Cyber, and minimizes risk by identifying and forecasting vulnerabilities. Without the Insight IDR and Insight VM, remediation and RCA efforts significantly prevent our cyber staff and law enforcement from performing their jobs. The total cost is \$150,670.00 and we would like to utilize the State of Ga Contract 99999-SPD-SPD0000060-0003. We solicited quotes from Insight, Dell, and SHI. SHI was the lowest, so we are requesting to award to them.

The Information Technology Department requests that P&C submit an agenda item to the BOC at the earliest date possible to ensure BOC approval.
