**PURPOSE:**

To certify the estimated roll-back rates for 2025 to the county board of tax assessors and county tax commissioner.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

O.C.G.A. 48-5-306.2 requires taxing authorities that levy ad valorem millage rates to calculate and certify the estimated roll-back rate to the County Board of Tax Assessors and the County Tax Commissioner. Based on calculations using preliminary 2025 tax digest data, this agenda item will certify the estimated roll-back rate for countywide maintenance and operations millage rates (County Operations/ General Fund and Hospital Fund) for 2025 as 9.737 mills and the estimated roll-back rate for DeKalb County School District for support and maintenance of education for 2025 as 22.780 mills.
