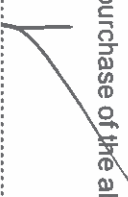

I. GENERAL:

DeKalb County, Georgia (County) Department of Public Works – Roads & Drainage Division's Traffic Engineering Area (R&D) is seeking qualified Contractors to perform and expeditiously complete Emergency Traffic Pavement Marking Services declared for approximately 70 miles of existing roadways throughout DeKalb County. Timeline for completion of work is requested within an approximate period of 8 to 12 months with production on an Emergency basis.

A. **Questions Deadline: by 9:00 AM (EST) on July 28, 2025** to County Contact (below).

B. **Bid Due Deadline: by 9:00 AM (EST) on August 11, 2025.**

II. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

A. All work is required to be completed in accordance with published guidelines by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT):

1. *GDOT Standard Specifications Construction of Transportation Systems, 2021 Edition dated 1/21/2021; within Section 600's* (see Link below).

- B. Successful Contractor must be registered with the State of Georgia Secretary of State's Office to do business in the State of Georgia.
- C. Successful Bidder must submit a GDOT Certificate of Qualification.
- D. Insurance:
 - 1. **Bidder must submit a copy of their Certificate of Insurance along with their Bid.**
 - 2. Successful bidder required to provide a signed and executed COI upon award of a contract.
- E. Permits are required.

III. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Required repainting and services are specified in the Price Schedule herein. Additional Emergency Traffic Pavement Marking Services may be requested for streets not listed herein.

- A. The awarded Contractor shall provide services as stated herein and have a proven record for successfully performing the services listed and required by the Specifications herein.
- B. The County classifies each project in this request as an “Emergency” service for the life of the contract and the need for production of services on an emergency basis. Since the need for services are not known at the time of execution, the County does not guarantee any minimum or maximum amounts.
- C. The County reserves the right to make multiple awards. The County is under no obligation to exclusively award this work to a single bidder nor is the County bound to a minimum contract amount.

D. COMMUNICATION

Work shall be done under the authority of the DeKalb County Department of Public Works-Roads & Drainage division/Traffic Engineering Area.

- 1. Upon award, and before starting work, the Contractor must furnish the County Contact a work list to be completed. Its order shall be in accordance to the County's “Priority Number” designated for each street name (as listed in the Price Schedule).
- 2. DeKalb County may at any time ask for an “updated” Work List from the Contractor, so to keep abreast of work progress. This work list must show what streets are Completed, or In Progress, and listed with respective details such as Street Name and its assigned “Priority Number”, type and measurement of work performed, Location and County Identification Numbers.

3. County required action or services will be performed timely so to prevent delay in the Contractor's performance or obligations under the terms of these Minimum Specifications. The County shall give written notice to the Contractor if it becomes aware of any changed circumstances.

E. RESPONSE TIME

Successful Bidder shall respond to service and inquiry calls within forty-eight (48) hours after receipt of the call from the County.

F. INVOICES

1. The County shall pay awarded Contractor(s) the prices stipulated in the Price Schedule and only for the actual quantities of work completed as determined and approved in writing by the County through observations and measurements of the work completed. Pay Term is Net 30 days.
2. The Contractor shall submit to the **County Contact** a separate invoice for each awarded project in the form acceptable to the County and accompanied by all supporting documentation requested by the County for payment of services.

- a. Invoices shall be itemized by each respective "GDOT Pay Item number" noted in the Description column in the Price Schedule. Any variation from the Price Schedule must be approved by the Public Works R&D Traffic Engineering Manager and supplemented to this contract prior to execution of the work. The County shall have right not to pay any invoice or part thereof if not properly supported.

- b. The County shall pay each invoice, or portion thereof as approved, provided that the approval or payment of any such invoice shall be considered to be evidence of performance by the Contractor. The County shall pay any undisputed items contained in such invoices.

G. PRICING

1. Bidders shall submit an all-inclusive, Lump Sum Price in the Price Schedule for all charges associated with completing Emergency Traffic Pavement Marking Services and in accordance with the Minimum Specifications outlined herein. Lump Sum Price shall include all things required to complete work; inclusive of labor and subcontractor labor, insurances, materials and equipment, fuel and transportation, traffic control management, etc. Pricing shall remain firm throughout the entire contract term.

2. The hyphenated numbers in the Description column of the Price Schedule represent references to the GDOT Pay Items.

H. CONTRACTOR'S WORK HOURS

1. All work shall be performed and completed Monday through Friday during regular, normal working hours unless the County is notified by the Contractor and receives approval at least 24 hours prior to a change in the work hours schedule. "Overtime" is not expected.

2. Regular Working hours are from 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM on local roads and 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM on collectors. Workday equals up to 8 hours on Monday through Friday during same regular working hours. Any exceptions will require written approval by the above County Contact Manager prior to the work being undertaken.
3. Work request may include Weekends, Holidays to avoid interruptions of traffic on an emergency nature. This will not be standard.
4. Adhere to the County's Noise Ordinance for machinery, power equipment, and construction noise prohibited between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
5. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to protect from damage and to repair, if damage occurs, all structures and fixtures not directly included in these projects. The Contractor shall protect river, canals, and drainage ditches from chemical contamination, sediment run-off, construction debris, and other damages.
