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Justification:

Four bids were received and deemed responsive and responsible from the following firms:

GS Construction Inc.
Inliner Solutions, LLC
SAK Construction, LLC
Vortex Services, LLC

DWM reviewed each line item from each bid to determine the overall lowest responsible and responsive bidders.

Of the four bids, the overall lowest responsive and responsible bid is from from SAK Construction, LLC. The second overall lowest is from Vortex Services, LLC.

DWM therefore recommends award in the amount of \$36,239,047.00 to SAK Construction, LLC and \$39,587,580.00 to Vortex Services, LLC. This figure represents half of their respective bids at \$75,826,623.00

The scope of this contract addresses three primary goals. 1) It allows the County to provide timely repairs to the sanitary sewer system in assets that are found to be at imminent failure before an SSO occurs countywide. Current sewer rehab contracts are focused on the priority areas or are emergency repair contracts. 2) This contract can be used to perform sewer rehabilitation in support of large development through the County's Capacity Assurance Program. 3) Structural related SSOs, whether on the Priority Fix List or stand alone, can be addressed through this contract.
