The proposer agrees to be available by phone as well as in-person to triage and consult on crisis situations.</p> <p>Proposer would provide external resources covered under the employee's behavioral health insurance carrier to impacted employees for post incident; not covered by MLCC.</p> <p>Implementation would include collaboration with Fire Rescue Department to roll out the program through in-person and virtual sessions.</p> <p>Proposed that employees agree to a wellness visit annually.</p> <p>Communication between chain of command.</p>	<p>Comments about this criterion include the following:</p> <p>Policy Development - No method was mentioned.</p> <p>Crisis Management: The proposer referenced a case regarding Jaeson Daniels and disclosed confidential information. This was noted by the committee as inappropriate and a violation of confidentiality.</p> <p>The proposer's services are more in-line with a general counseling service provider.</p>

The proposer provided 3-6 months and 6-12 months plans.</p> <p>Annual Report - A summative report will be provided annually to include utilization rate, mental health themes generated from outcome/feedback surveys, recommendations, and future programming plans.</p> <p>Invoicing: Invoice will be provided for all services rendered to the Agency due the first week of each month. provided by the subcontractors as well.</p>	<p>Comments about this criterion include the following: It was noted that no specific subcontractors were provided with the submitted proposal.</p> <p>Service Delivery includes medication administration, supplements and drugs, which is not appropriate services the user department is requesting. Medication administration was noted as a risk factor for the County.</p> <p>Holistic approach with supplemental drugs are not appropriate as a plan action.</p> <p>The sourcing for external assistance will be the responsibility of Fire Rescue.</p> <p>Crisis Assessment Response Time - Ambiguity with delivery of services with crisis assessment response time. The proposer stated within 2 hours of contact by the County. However the proposer state triage, crisis consultation and critical incident stress debriefing would be within 72 hours?</p>
