**Personnel Narrative**

The full-time Assistant Solicitor-General dedicates 100% of her/his time to the project. She is responsible for prosecuting or perusing prosecution on cases assigned to the Special Victims Unit (SVU) of the Office. While the attorney dedicates one hundred percent of her time prosecuting misdemeanor VAWA related crimes, only 72% of Juliana's total salary is covered by the grant.

**B. Fringe Benefits** – Fringe benefits must be based on actual known costs or an established formula. Fringe benefits are for the personnel listed in budget category (A) and only for the percentage of time devoted to the project. Fringe benefits on overtime hours are limited to FICA, Worker's Compensation, and Unemployment Compensation.

**Fringe Benefits Narrative**

DeKalb County Solicitor General's Office is requesting fringe benefits for the Attorney II assigned to cases involving VAWA crimes. Cost for Health Insurance reflects cost based on percentage of time projected on the project. Employee FICA and Pension are percentages determined by the county. 72% of Juliana's benefits are supported by VAWA grant funding.
