This DeKalb County road project limits extends from US 23/SR 42 to Woodstock/Bailey/Constitution/Fayetteville/Fleetwood Intersection. This authorization is proposing to use SPLOST funds from Category 1B Federal and State Transportation Project Matching Funds for Transportation Purposes. This authorization shall not exceed a total SPLOST amount of \$3,614,622.00.

5. Need and Purpose:

The Metro South Community Improvement District (MSCID) has received a \$1 million Georgia Transportation Infrastructure Bank (GTIB) grant for safety and operational improvements to the Constitution Road Freight Corridor. Proposed improvements include intersection improvements and a traffic signal at the SR 42/ Bailey Street intersection and a roundabout at the Bailey St. /Fayetteville Rd. /Fleetwood Dr. /Woodstock Rd. intersection. The project will improve access to SR 42 and I-285 for the numerous freight and truck oriented businesses in the Constitution Road area.
