The aforementioned contract is set to expire October 31, 2018 and requires a renewal for utilization by the Department of Watershed Management for the period of October 11, 2018 – October 31, 2019 to continue to remove sand, silt, mud and debris from the water mains, clearwells, tanks, reservoir leaf screens, reservoir valves, raw water pump intake wet wells, and traveling screen bays, from the river side of the bar screens at Holcomb Bridge River station. The diving services are critical to the continuity of the water supply to Scott Candler Water Treatment Plant and with the impending increase in sand accumulation (historical trend data indications) will denote the increase in necessary funding. tdk 8/16/18
