## Proposal for Emergency Shelter & Bridge Housing Updated June 14, 2024

Shown below are the costs associated with the provision of shelter services to address some of the immediate shelter needs for the DeKalb County unsheltered population. The recommended services are designed to address the disparate needs of households with children and single individuals. Service extent is scaled to fit within the \$1 million cost limit.

## **Assumptions:**

- I. Primarily, Bridge Housing will be used to provide shelter for households with children.
  - A. Apartments 6 units

- B. Our House Non-congregate shelter/Bridge Housing units
- II. Ten (10) hotel rooms will be used primarily for single adults. Nightly cost for hotel rooms at compliant, safe hotels average \$70 plus \$5 State tax.
- III. To expand normal emergency bed capacity, Community Development will contract with Salvation Army for the provision of 5 family beds and 9 single beds.
- IV. Experienced non-profit agencies will provide case management and assist households in moving to stability and self-sufficiency.
- V. Coordinated Entry and Outreach resources are included to ensure engagement of unsheltered individuals, increase access to services, ensure equity, and facilitate data accumulation to inform process improvement.
- VI. Community Development will contract for Housing Navigator services to assist households in locating, standard, code compliant affordable housing.
- VII. Participants will cycle through emergency shelter and bridge housing every 90-120 days.
