Additionally, it will support the 2024 GALEO Institute for Leadership Cohort. The cohort will have 25-40 members of early to mid-career Latinos. The annual cost to run the GIL program is \$157,125, resulting in an average cost per student of approximately \$5,000, which is significantly subsidized to only cost the participants \$250 for the entire year.
