AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS REVISED 1988, CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE XXI, SECTION 362, PERTAINING TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority of DeKalb County is tasked with the protection of the county's public health, safety, and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 40-6-371(a) authorizes counties to enact ordinances which regulate stopping, standing or parking with respect to streets; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 of the Code of DeKalb County Code, as revised 1988, currently regulates motor vehicles, stopping, standing, and parking on streets in unincorporated DeKalb County; and

WHEREAS, the Dekalb County Board of Commissioners desires to protect the public's health, safety, and general welfare by restricting parking on a certain street on which parking is currently authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of same, that Chapter 17 of the Code of Dekalb County, Georgia, as Revised 1988, be amended as follows:

PART I. ENACTMENT

Section 17-362 shall be amended to add the following street to the existing list of streets, in alphabetical order:

Sec. 17-362. – No parking generally.

Cedar Crest Way, both sides, from High Grove Lane to the cul-de-sac, no parking anytime.

PART II. Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective immediately on the date of adoption by the Board of Commissioners and approval by the Chief Executive officer.

PART III. Severability

Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, nor any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional. All ordinances or resolution, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.
