 The aforementioned contract is set to expire November 6, 2018 and requires a renewal for utilization by the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) for the period of November 7, 2018 – November 6, 2019. This contract provides electric motor repairs for the Water Plant, two (2) Wastewater Treatment Plants, ten (10) Pump Stations and sixty-four (64) Lift Stations around DeKalb County. DWM currently has motors ranging in size from 2700 HP (@4160 volts) to 5 HP; these pump/motor combinations are used to provide safe drinking water and manage sewage processing.
