EXPERIENCE

Charles L. Martin is an attorney who has represented disabled individuals, primarily in Social Security disability cases, since 1977. He has represented thousands of disabled individuals with hundreds of different disabilities, and has developed an understanding of and sensitivity to the needs of individuals with disabilities. Most of his Social Security work is currently in appeals in the federal courts. He is a frequent speaker at state and national conferences on Social Security law.

From 1988 through 1997, Martin served as the attorney-advisor to the Director of the Client Assistance Program (a program funded under the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 for Vocational Rehabilitation clients), and his staff, provided legal services to CAP clients as requested by the CAP Director, and trained CAP and Vocational Rehabilitation staff on rehabilitation law.

In 1997, the Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation program contracted with the Law Offices of Charles L. Martin to operate the Georgia CAP, and Charles L. Martin became the Director of the Georgia CAP. In 2001, the Governor designated the law firm of Martin and Jones to operate the Georgia CAP, and Charles L. Martin remained the CAP Director.

Charles L. Martin has a national reputation in both the Social Security law and CAP communities, and often provides free mentoring for attorneys, advocates and CAP directors. He worked closely with the former CAP director to formulate CAP policy, periodically consults with managers and

policy-makers of the Georgia Vocational Rehabilitation program. He served on the Statewide Rehabilitation Council for seven years, and is currently on the Board of Directors of the National Organization of Social Security Claimant's Representatives.

In addition to his work in the disability community, when his two sons were younger he served as an adult leader with the Boy Scouts of America, in Troop 175. Decatur, Georgia. He previously founded and coached a chess club at Glennwood Elementary School, Decatur, Georgia.
