

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA TO THE DEKALB COUNTY DELEGATION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORT TAXABATEMENT REFORM.

WHEREAS, Tax Abatement is an unconstrained power granted to unelected Development Authorities that when misused can result in the transfer of needed revenues from one level of local government to another with no consideration of equity or impact;

WHEREAS, Tax Abatement should be constrained to ensure that public resources are not needlessly transferred to a private party, or to another unit of government;

WHEREAS, Reforms should focus on qualifying private properties for tax abatement, the transfer of resources or benefit from one unit of government to another, and strengthening the opportunities for public and private stakeholders to challenge tax abatement through bond validation hearings; and,

WHEREAS, Representatives within the Georgia General Assembly and other entities including ACCG, have supported efforts of Tax Abatement reform in Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERING AUTHORITY OF DEKALB COUNTY GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWED:

1. The Dekalb County Delegation of the General Assembly support the proposed House Bill 24 that provides County Governing Authorities with the ability to object to annexations based on proposed tax abatements, rebates, and other financial incentives;
2. In addition to the request that the General Assembly convene a study committee to review tax abatement reform;
3. Review the attached Exhibit A for potential options for improvement;
