

Linda is a longtime resident of the Peters Park community. The street she lives on bears her family's name. Linda is one of several residents in that community who have grown increasingly concerned about deterioration in her neighborhood which surrounds the William McKinley Peters Park. Linda has worked closely with the city of Tucker, Dekalb County Code Enforcement, and local business leaders in order to restore the Peters Park community to what it once was. She currently serves as the President of the Peters Park Committee as well as President of the Friends of Peters Park.

Linda was selected by the city of Tucker as it's Citizen of the Month in June of 2018. And while she has accomplished much, she will tell you there is still much work to do. Under the leadership of Linda Clark, the Peters community united in 2018 to engage neighbors for the common good with the theme of "Becoming Neighbors Again."

Currently, Linda is working on a fund-raising project to provide new action-fit exercise equipment for Peters Park. Funds raised for this project will be matched by a grant of up to \$4,000 from Park Pride. Under Linda's leadership, Friends of Peters Park has partnered with Friends of Tucker Parks to facilitate park improvements.
