- All Motorola procurement transactions were done as Sole Sources.
- The County upgraded to the current P-25 equipment in 2006 under 06-900263. Expired 05/22/12. Amount Spent To Date: \$19,927,502.87
- County procured a radio system upgrade in equipment and maintenance services in order to ensure the recording system is in compliance with the Georgia Records Act OCGA 50-18-90 and the County’s retention requirement to retain all digital and analog recordings of E911 center’s incoming and outgoing calls. We upgraded from platform 7.7 to 7.14 in 2012 under 12-902541 this was Change Order #1 on 11/07/14. BOC approval not required because the amount of the amendment is \$0. (Upgrade)



- Change Order #2 approved by BOC on 07/12/16 to increase the contract for an amount not to exceed by \$303,210.55. (Upgrade)
- This Sole Source will allow the County to transition to the upgrade of Phase II with the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) system. Currently Clayton, Fulton, Gwinnett, Cobb and City of Atlanta all utilize Phase II and are able to interface with each other via this system. In order for them to interface with DeKalb, they have to exit the UASI system and contact DeKalb via an alternative route.
