

TRAFFIC CALMING RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES (SPEED TABLES) ON BEECH DRIVE BETWEEN MIDWAY ROAD AND COVINGTON HIGHWAY AND THE ASSESSMENT OF THE ANNUAL COST OF MAINTAINING SAID TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON THE AFOREMENTIONED RESIDENTIAL STREET.

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section II, Paragraph VI, of the Constitution of the State of Georgia of 1983 authorizes and empowers the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County, Georgia, to establish special tax districts, in as such as this resolution creates said district for the purpose of constructing, erecting, establishing, and maintaining traffic calming measures on residential streets in DeKalb County, and to levy a special assessment or tax against all property designated to be affected by these functions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County, Georgia, adopted the DeKalb County Cut-Through Program on May 23, 1995, which program authorizes the measures contemplated herein; and

WHEREAS, the owners of sixty-five (65) percent or more of the property within Traffic Calming District Number 23-15-10 have petitioned the Board of Commissioners of DeKalb County, Georgia, for the installation of traffic calming measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, DeKalb County, Georgia, as the governing body of said County, that there be and there is hereby created and established within the area of DeKalb County, Traffic Calming District Number 23-15-10, for the purpose of constructing, erecting, establishing, and maintaining traffic calming measures (**speed tables**) to reduce speeding on residential streets, and ways therein, located in Land Lot 219 of the 15th District; of DeKalb County, Georgia, consisting of all or portions of property on the following street, Beech Drive between Midway Road and Covington Highway as more particularly shown and delineated on map entitled "Traffic Calming District Number 23-15-10, which map is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution by reference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the boundaries of said district as enumerated on said map as the affected area be the same and hereby established as shown and delineated on said map as full and complete as if the legal description of the courses, distances, and boundaries of said district were fully set forth herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual maintenance cost and charges shall not exceed \$25.00 per property owner, and shall be a lien upon the abutting property annually FROM January 1st next and continuing each year through the life of the traffic calming measures (**speed tables**), however, that said annual maintenance charges may be increased or decreased by the Board of Commissioners to reflect changes in operating and maintenance costs.

IT IS DIRECTED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Tax Commissioner of DeKalb County, Georgia, for the collection of any and all taxes and/or special assessments and/or service charges which may be imposed against any and all businesses, residents, and property served by said facilities.
