



## **2024-2025 Scope of Work**

Women Moving On, Inc is requesting \$65,000 in funding to support our legal advocacy program and Gamechangers, a 12-month teen program for individuals who have experienced domestic violence in their homes.

In 2023, our legal advocacy program received and responded to 13,393 calls for legal assistance from individuals seeking to file Temporary Protective Oder (TPO) petitions. We assisted 5,785 individuals with petitions. In addition to calls for TPOS, our legal advocates supported 926 survivors to court hearings.

We are requesting \$35,000 to assist and provide resources for 1000 clients @\$83.00 per day for identifying, planning, and developing a safety/escape plan and/or the resources to ensure that the client is prepared to address the court related process to obtain and manage safety. Some of this cost was previously covered by a DeKalb County federal grant through the Department of Justice. The funds for this position expire on September 30, 2024. This funding will augment assistance beginning on October 1, 2024, and concluding on September 30, 2025.

We are also requesting \$30,000 to cover the cost of **20** DeKalb County teenagers who have been exposed to domestic violence in their homes. The cost for each teenager is \$2,000 for a 12 month program. The total cost for this program is \$60,000. The remaining \$30,000 has been committed through the Cigna Foundation. \$30,000 will cover the following:

- 24 support groups
- 24 Individual Therapy Sessions
- 24 Life Skills Class
- 24 Social Emotional, Ethical Learning Sessions
- 10 Field Trips
- 24 Cognitive Based Compassion Training (CBCT) Sessions
- Timeline: November 1, 2024-October 20, 2025
