## 5. Need and Purpose:

Panola Road is an important north-south corridor in south DeKalb County. Prior to creation of the City of Stonecrest, DeKalb County worked with GDOT on the design of improvements to Panola Road. Proposed improvements from that effort exceed funding capabilities for the city and county. The proposed scoping study will provide an updated traffic analysis and evaluate alternative roadway improvements. The final product will be a GDOT concept report for the preferred alternative that will facilitate seeking GDOT project funding. The proposed IGA calls for the City of Stonecrest to reimburse the county for 50 percent of the cost up to \$200,000.00.
