**Detailed Description of Requested Changes:** We are requesting to add Roads & Drainage to Watershed's existing contract for ITB No. 21-101345 Salt for CPA 1266062 F. M. Shelton, Inc. We also request to add \$113,760.00, to the contract cap the purchase of an additional 600 Unit Tons of salt.

The addition will allow for Roads and Drainage to have a more fluid purchasing process for procuring road salt in large enough quantities to restock winter weather emergency response materials.
