Consists of providing continued advisory consulting on project coordination, acquisitions, implementation of the CAPRA regulations to maintain the accreditation which RPCA was awarded in 2019, and to manage to completion six recent grant awards which were executed in 2023 in the amount of \$10,263,914.65.

Awarded through an Exemption on September 9, 2021, the first renewal was approved on September 30, 2022, for an amount not to exceed \$93,500. This contract consists of providing continued advisory consulting on project coordination, acquisitions, implementation of the CAPRA regulations to maintain the accreditation which RPCA was awarded in 2019, and to manage to completion six recent grant awards which were executed in 2023 in the amount of \$10,263,914.65.
