Detailed Description of Requested Changes:

The initial, subsequent renewal and change order budgets for the Disaster Recovery and Sewage Cleaning Services contracts were derived from the previous year's expenditures not taking in account the increase shortfall to Disaster Recovery and Sewage Cleaning Services contract will be \$415,000.00 that is necessary for the department to provide the services through the end of the contract term.

Facilities Management is requesting a change order be added to the existing contract (1048832) with Bell Restoration Due to the number of facilities with confirmed mold growth. We recommend adding \$350,000 to the contract. This rough estimate was determined by the number of mold incidents that has occurred in 2017, and the average cost of repairs for those facilities.
