Detailed Description of Requested Changes:

The Department of Watershed Management is requesting an increase to our contracted Tree Cutting and Removal Services budget to make certain that services are not interrupted during the 2018 calendar year. The increase in funding will ensure that the County will provide the surety that all County owned trees are maintained in a safe condition to reduce the County's liability and satisfy the timely disbursements to our vendors for services rendered.



Justification for the Proposed Changes and an Explanation of why the County should not consider a Competitive Bid:

Tree Cutting Removal Services initial budget was derived from the previous year's expenditures not taking in account the increase from emergency services from the weather related storms; leaving the budget underfunded. If the essential adjustments are not met then the projected shortfall to the Tree Cutting Removal Services will be \$470,000.00 that is necessary for the department to provide the services through the end of the year.

Detailed description of Requested Changes: We are requesting additional compensation to continue to provide professional tree removal services to the Park Sites in DeKalb County Georgia.

Justification for the Proposed Changes and an Explanation of why the County should not consider a Competitive Bid: We are currently under contract with these contractors to provide professional tree services. Thus, there is no need for a competitive bid. The additional funds are needed to ensure that we are able to provide dangerous tree and stump removal, tree trimming and emergency tree removal services while the Purchasing and Contracting Department works to rebid the contract.

Based upon the current expenditure rate, we do not have sufficient funding to support services through December 31, 2018. We are requesting funding in the amount of \$200,000.00 to be split as requested below:

- \$100,000 ArborServ, Inc.
- \$100,000 Casey Tree Experts

Detailed Description of Requested Changes: To add \$1,000,000.00 to the current contract with AuborServ and \$250,000.00 to the contract with Casey Tree Experts to ensure that there are adequate funds on the contract to enable the contractor to continue working on the backlog of trees and debris removal projects.

Justification for the Proposed Changes and an Explanation of why the County should not consider a Competitive Bid. ArboServ Inc. and Casey Tree Experts were two contractors that were awarded contracts in response to ITB # 15-3003423. Both contractors worked with Roads & Drainage on the large backlog of trees and debris removal. Both contracts expire on August 31, 2018 but the available funds are almost depleted. We are working hard to reduce the growing backlog of trees and debris removal projects.
