- 1. Billing Flow Monitoring Sites(Revenue DeKalb County Sites). DeKalb County have agreements with many adjacent Counties/municipalities to sell or buy sewer treatment. These Flow Monitors are considered permanent sites.
- 2. Installation of Flow Monitors in order to create, maintained and keep up to date our DeKalb Sewer Model(currently part of our Consent Decree). These Flow Monitors are considered permanent sites.
- 3. Installation of Capacity Request Flow Monitors for new development. These Flow Monitors are considered temporary sites and are remove/relocated once it is determined we can/cannot accommodate requested demand.
- 4. Installation Flow Monitors due to Sewer Petition Requests. These Flow Monitors are considered temporary sites and are remove/relocated once it is determined we can/cannot accommodate requested demand.
