**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF DEKALB
COUNTY, GEORGIA TO THE DEKALB COUNTY DELEGATION OF THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY RELATING TO REPEAL OF LAW RELATED TO
CONFEDERATE MONUMENTS ON PROPERTY OWNED BY COUNTIES,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

\WHEREAS, the governing authority of DeKalb County requests the General Assembly to enact legislation that repeals O.C.G.A. 50-3-1, which, in part, limits the actions taken by counties vis-a-vis confederate monuments located on county-owned property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing authority of DeKalb County, Georgia that the following is requested:

1. The Georgia General Assembly repeal that portion of O.C.G.A. Section 50-3-1 which limits actions taken by counties vis-à-vis confederate monuments located on County-owned property.
2. The Executive Assistant or designee deliver a copy of this Resolution to each member of the Georgia General Assembly representing a portion of DeKalb County.
