#### **PURPOSE:**

P&C worked collaboratively with the user departments to develop this solicitation and it advertised in July 2018.

- 1. The current contract solicited in FY2015 did not contain estimated quantities because typically an on-call services contract does not contain estimated quantities. Estimated quantities are standard for commodities (bulk) type procurements not for services that will be utilized on an as needed basis and usage is unknown. There is no way to calculate a volume of trees that will die or fall within a year to quantify an estimated amount for the ITB. This on-call services contract is utilized by various County departments and although their service needs are similar; their usage is specific in nature to their operations, so it was determined that this would be an all award to multiple vendors to meet or exceed the County's need. A line item bid would not be appropriate for an on-call tree contract because it is unusual for a department to remove a single tree at a time. For example, RPCA, typically, will have several trees (different sizes, etc.) in one park location that need to be removed. It would not feasible to have one vendor remove a 12" tree and another vendor remove a 24" tree and another a 48" tree. Better pricing is obtained for one contractor to remove all trees at the same time (one work order request).
- 2. The user departments have various needs and volume usage; therefore, the awarded amounts are based on their individual need assessment and historical usage data. Work orders will be assigned to the lowest cost quote received from the three awarded vendors and their availability and schedule especially during storm events. We must have a way to be able to handle all tree requests when notified and if the lowest vendor is unavailable then we can utilize the next lowest quoted vendor. We can't wait for the lower priced contractor to become available when it comes to the removal of dangerous or emergency trees. That's not logical or practical and would cause a threat to public safety and welfare.
- 3. A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held and the solicitation requirements/price schedule was explained and questions answered. Seven (7) questions were officially received from the vendor market and two (2) questions were in regard to per inch for stump removal and root balls larger than 75 inches (Addendum #3). The County's answer regarding per inch for stump removal was to provide pricing as stated in the price schedule and the answer regarding root ball larger than 75 inches was this assumption needs to be included in their price schedule pricing. After receipt of bid submissions, P&C addressed and researched these potential errors/price differences for line items 43 thru 53. The vendors were contacted to verify the prices submitted and confirmed that the prices were per stump and not inches or acres as stated in the solicitation. It has been determined that these line items will not be awarded due to the price variances and has been reflected in the revised bid tabulation.

- 4. The user departments have various needs and volume usage; therefore, the awarded amounts are based on their individual need assessment and historical usage data. The user departments will submit a revised award recommendation to divide their funding amount equally amongst the three awarded vendors.
- 5. The responsive and responsible bidders provided the required licenses and the numbers were verified by P&C. The user departments will manage the contracts and ensure that these licenses are maintained during the term of the contract.
- K2R Legacy did provide the documentation of an Arborist license for Doni Jones with Don's Tree
  Services who agrees to work with the contracted vendor to provide these services. The license
  was verified and is valid through June 30, 2020.

# ITB18-100975 for Tree Cutting | and Removal Services (Annual Contract with Options to Renew)

#### **Evaluation Report**

- 1. Bid Opening occurred on 9/17/18 and five bids were received.
- 2. Responsive Evaluation
  - a. Georgia Power was deemed non-responsive for failure to submit the price schedule in a separate sealed envelope.
  - b. C & C Disaster Tree Service was deemed non-responsive for failure to meet the requirement for a minimum of 5 years' experience.
  - c. Casey Tree Experts did not meet the LSBE participation benchmark but provided GFE which was approved by the CPO and remained responsive.
  - d. K2R Legacy Group and Arborserv were responsive.
- 3. The Price Schedule for the three (3) responsive bidders were opened on 9/20/18.
- 4. The Bid Tabulation was prepared and posted to the County website on 10/4/18.
- 5. The agenda item package was initiated, and the solicitation was reviewed in depth.
  - a. Corrections were made to calculations and typographical errors on Bid Tabulation (attached to the substitute agenda item).
- 6. Costs were examined as some were out of a competitive range (unbalanced bid). These line items will not be considered for an award and has been removed from the substitute agenda item.
- 7. The greatest variations of pricing occurred for stump grinding and other services, specifically items by vendor:
  - a. Arborsery 44 50, 53 and 54. Pricing appears consistent with historical pricing, but historical pricing had a different unit of measure.
  - b. K2R 44 48. No historical background but pricing appears to be per stump rather than the requested per inch.
- 8. On 1/3/19, bidders were asked to confirm that all submitted prices would be honored and all confirmed they would.
- 9. The issue regarding unbalanced bids was not resolved through the price confirmation. Discussions ensued, and P&C proceeded with obtaining clarification regarding the unit of measure that Arborserv and K2R used for the bids provided on the items in question. (See 7 above.) The goal was to obtain additional information to clarify how the bids were calculated without allowing bidders to submit corrected (different) pricing. Bidders were specifically told that this was not a request for submittal of new pricing. Clarifications were requested from both bidders on 1/8/19.
- 10. Arborserv's response provided the information as requested. The original bid price for stump grinding and root ball removal was confirmed as being accurately stated per inch. Even though Arborserv confirmed the price for stump grinding was per inch, this is inconsistent with their pricing provided on the previous contract which was \$4.50. The same conclusion is drawn regarding root ball removal. The last contract for root ball

removal with Arborserv was priced at \$100 per root ball and their current bid price is \$200.00 per inch. The response to the clarification of Items 49 and 50 supports that these items were incorrectly bid. The unit of measure for Items 49, 50 and 53 on the last contract was per linear foot and Arborserv indicated that the unit of measure for their bid on these items was per linear foot, not per acre as requested. There are 835 linear feet per acre and when converted, makes Arborserv the lowest bidder on the items. Note that Item 53, Bush & Vegetation Clearing, was not included in error but it is concluded that the same situation exists with the per acre unit of measure requested vs per linear foot bid. This item was omitted from the clarification process but appears to be like Items 49 and 50. The below conversions are from linear feet to per acre using the submitted bid price.

11. K2R was requested to provide a clarification for Items 44 – 48 by providing the unit of measure used to calculate the Bid Price. They responded by providing new pricing which is the Bid Price divided by largest diameter inch per line item. Example: \$65 divided by 24 = \$2.71. The unrequested submittal of new pricing for stump grinding appears to indicate that the unit of measure of the price bid was per stump not per inch as requested.

12. After thorough review, it is recommended that Items 43 – 50, 53 and 54 be removed from consideration of award, as these items are included in the other line items for tree removal w/stump grinding and tree removal with root ball removal. It is further recommended that the remaining items be awarded equally among the responsive and responsible bidders. When a need arises, the County (user departments) will obtain quotes from all three (3) bidders and award the work based on lowest cost and the vendor's availability to perform the work.
