Notes:

- National gasoline prices are based off <u>retail</u> prices which incorporate state taxes, refining costs, transportation, marketing, excise taxes and the cost of the raw materials used to produce the crude oil. The Coop prices seen in the graph above are based off of the Opis Rack rate which is the <u>wholesale</u> rate of gasoline with the added markup/discount submitted by the bidder. The Opis rate changes daily so the only constant is the markup/discount bid by the vendors. Because the Opis rate is the wholesale price on gasoline, the county can count on getting a generally lower rate at a fair price.
