SUBJECT:

Rehabilitation of the Leeshire and Hammer Mill # 3 lift stations

Dekalb County Consent Decree mandates that the rehabilitation work on all the lift stations must be completed by Dec 31, 2019. Back in 10/2/2017 SOL Construction was given a contract (#1073322) valued at \$5,705,060 to rehab five stations and replace a force main (Stone Mill-1, Stone Mill-2, Penny Brook, Fourth Street, Lewis Way and the Force Main at Penny Brook). The expiration date for their contract was indicated as December 31, 2019. By December 18, 2018 all five stations and the force main achieved substantial completion and operation took beneficial use of the stations. At the end of the original scope we were left with \$1,198, 309.21 in that contract that could be used for other projects. Faced with a deadline of 12/31/2019 DWM seeks to ratify the remaining funds in contract #1073322 toward other pressing lift station projects as follows:

LEESHIRE LIFT STATION:

Leeshire Lift Station is a very old and dilapidated below ground station that was supposed to be switched to gravity by December 2019. Due to logistical constraints and difficulty acquiring the required easements for the gravity line, by October 2018, it became obvious that Leeshire station could not be eliminated and switched to gravity by the referenced date. Consequently, to meet the Consent Decree requirements, DWM decided to rehab that station instead. During the planning phase DWM Operations suggested that we replace the existing station with a submersible station. The idea was to reuse the existing wet well and replace the below ground station with a submersible system that is user-friendly, would require less maintenance and is much safer to operate. To meet the December 31, 2019 deadline and since we had funds available in our contract with SOL, DWM decided to fast track this project and get it done under Chief Executive Officer Michael Thurmond

To meet the Consent Decree requirements the pump station at Hammer Mill #3 was replaced by Dekalb County C&M but was not finished. The pad was not installed, and to secure the station a new fence was in order. This project was also fast tracked to meet the December 31, 2019 deadline. Again, to meet the consent decree deadline of 12/31/2019 this project was started, fast tracked and finished so that we could concentrate on the Leeshire station.
