- l. The Georgia General Assembly repeal that portion of O.C.G.A. Section 50-3-1 which limits actions taken by counties vis-à-vis confederate monuments located on County-owned property.
- 2. The Executive Assistant or designee deliver a copy of this Resolution to each member of the Georgia General Assembly representing a portion of DeKalb County.
