Justification:

The aforementioned contract is set to expire December 31, 2019 and requires a renewal for utilization by the Department of Watershed Management (DWM) for the period of January 1, 2020 – December 31, 2020 to continue to utilize the salt, allowing the water plant the ability to produce disinfectant. DWM's plan for the next fiscal term is to operate the Hypo Generation System to produce 0.8% hypochlorite as a redundant disinfectant as a backup to the bulk bleach process and the primary disinfection ozone process. DWM requires brine, "salt", in order to generate sodium hypochlorite.
