McLendon Monuments did not attend a Mandatory DeKalb First LSBE Meeting, but it has been included herein because it submitted a bid for the previous ITB. Only a small number of vendors can provide granite rubble stone; most stone vendors in the stone marketplace supply gravel stone, which is not the type of stone used by the County. The final response appears to have been reasonable, given that there was such a limited marketplace.
