

Snapfinger AWTP Phase 2 CM Services Request for Approval of: Change Order No. 3

Background

In August 2013, Tetra Tech (Tt) was contracted by DeKalb County's Department of Watershed Management (DWM) to provide Construction Management Services for the Snapfinger AWTP Phase 2 project. In August 2015 construction began, and Tt was mobilized to the site to oversee construction activities being performed by the selected Contractor, Archer Western, LTD (Archer Western). The Tt field team consists of the following ten (10) staff members:

- Resident Engineer (Tt)
- Construction Manager (Tt)
- Deputy Construction Manager (LSBE)
- Process/Mechanical Inspector (LSBE)
- Electrical Inspector (LSBE)
- Site/Civil Inspector (LSBE)
- Structural Inspector (LSBE)
- Field Technician (LSBE)
- Construction Documents Administrator (LSBE)
- Assistant Construction Documents Administrator (LSBE)

In September 2017, Tt received approval of Change Order No.1 from DWM which authorized additional funds for Tt to continue to provide Construction Management Services for the Snapfinger AWTP Phase 2 project through October 31, 2020. Since that time DWM has requested that Tt submit documentation regarding the need for an additional amendment (Change Order No. 2) to align Tt's contract with that of Archer Western. Specifically, this Change Order summarized the need for Tt staff to work overtime hours, at a time and a half rate when applicable, due to Archer Western working twelve-hour workdays, versus the eight-hour workday in Tt's contract. Changer Order No. 2 was approved by the Board of Commissioners in December 2019.

Additionally, to reduce the negative float on the project, DeKalb County came to an agreement with Archer Western in February 2020 to allow Saturday work hours. Tt has been instructed to cover this additional overtime under the existing contract and seek further funding in this amendment (Change Order No. 3). As a result of the previously described modifications, Tetra Tech's existing contract funds are expected to expire in August 2020 vs. the contract end date of October 31, 2020.

At the request of the Owner, this Change Order includes the following services:

- 1. Extension of Tt's contract through June 30,2022, at the contracted straight-time hourly rates, for the first forty (40) hours of construction management services per week.
- 2. Extension of Tt's contract through June 30, 2022 for overtime coverage (straight time and time and a half, where applicable) Monday to Friday and Saturdays.

- 3. Funding for the review of Time Impact Analysis (TIA's) submitted by the Contractor in accordance with the Executive Level Agreement established between all parties in September 2018.
- 4. Recovery of expended funds related to additional services needed to process the high number of Potential Change Orders (PCOs) received on the project.

Amendment Basis

This amendment includes the extension of Tetra Tech's services from August 20,2020 to June 30,2022 (one month after Archer Western's currently projected completion date), a time period of ninety-seven (97) weeks. This amendment requests funding for Tetra Tech to continue to provide construction management services, Monday to Friday, for 40 hours per week, in addition to overtime hours (Monday to Friday & Saturdays) as summarized in **Table 1** below. It should be noted that this request for overtime also includes funding for the project's Construction Document's Administrator due to a higher level of effort than originally anticipated being required of the position. A letter from Tetra Tech's LSBE sub-consultant, Graham & Associates, summarizes this increased level of effort (**Attachment 1**).

Note: Time and Half compensation is only being requested for hourly employees

Tetra Tech has also included costs for the additional temporary personnel that were used on the project to expedite the review and processing of the extensive volume of Potential Change Orders (PCOs) and delay claims submitted by the Contractor in 2017. Documentation from Tt to DWM staff requesting approval for this work is provided in **Attachment 2**. Tt has already been paid for this work and is only asking for an increase in our upper limit to ensure enough funding capacity for the project. Lastly, in September 2018, Tt was directed by DWM to begin the monthly analysis of additional TIA's submitted by the contractor which exceed the one (1) TIA included in Tt's base scope of work (**Attachment 3**). As such, this amendment includes funding for Tt staff to analyze an additional three (3) TIA's per month through June 2022.

Schedule

Tt is seeking additional funding for the period between August 20, 2020 (the projected expiration date of existing contracts funds) to June 30, 2022 (approximately one month after the currently projected completion date per Archer Western's latest Project Schedule Update).

Proposed Fee

The proposed fee for the above Scope of Work is \$9,162,850 to be billed on a Time and Materials basis (Attachment 4). Please note that the presented billing rates represent Tetra Tech's billing rates for Year 8 of our contract, which begins on August 20, 2020, and will escalate at a rate of 3% per year, in agreement with the Contract.

Due to the significant amount of changes to project drawings as well as increase in RFIs, Proposed Change Orders & Field Orders for work associated with the project, we are requesting for overtime for the Construction Document Administrator. These changes have resulted in an increased workload that is not manageable in a daily eight-hour time period.

Listed below are several statistics that the CDA executed/managed, as of January 31, 2020:

- 277 Proposed Change Orders processed to date
- 107 Request for Proposals processed to date
- 9 Change Order packages processed to date
- 196 Field Orders / Change Orders processed to date
- 1,172 RFIs processed to date. Please note that each RFI cycle requires four actions of review and transmittal generation (4,688)
- 2,785 submittals processed (including resubmittals). Please note that each Submittal cycle requires four actions of review and processing (11,140)
- 957 Drawings & Revised Drawings processed to date

These statistics are in addition to the other daily tasks for the CDA, including, but not limited to, other Change Management duties, Progress Payments tasks, Meeting Minutes, etc. Document storage includes the uploading of all project documentation to Tetra Tech's server, DeKalb County's SharePoint site and the construction productivity software application (PlanGrid).

The daily workload of the CDA is full of keeping track of the voluminous amounts of documentation and other duties for the position. However, with the Field Staff working additional hours, this has added to the CDA's existing heavy workload and is not sustainable. The CDA is now prioritizing tasks to make sure timesensitive activities and actions are handled timely while deferring other activities and actions for a later time.

Wendell,

Just following up on our conversation on-site yesterday about the level of effort that is required for Tt to manage Archer Western's submission of PCO's. Our contracted level of effort is based on Attachment A (attached to this email) in the original RFP where Parsons, as the design engineer, published their expected number of PCO's at 48. However, to date AW has submitted 114 EA PCO's, and right now with our current contracted staffing limitations, we are struggling to review and process the PCO's. Additionally, timely review of these PCO's is compounded by:

- The sheer number and pace of PCO's being generated by AW
- For additive PCO's, the proposed quantities and costs require significant time to reconcile
- For deductive PCO's, the proposed quantities and costs require significant time to reconcile
- Significant effort being spent by Mark Hedden and Edroy Adolphin on basic AW noncompliance items that result in less availability to process PCO's

With your concurrence, I will assign additional staff to assist with reviewing and managing these PCO's. As this level of effort is not in our current cost/scope, we will setup an additional internal task to track this effort and will communicate the progress and effort to you monthly.

Requested Construction Schedule Modifications

Dear Mr. Dunaway,

In a good faith effort to aid the Contractor in accurately scheduling the Work for the Snapfinger AWTF Phase 2 project, and per the meeting held on September 10, 2018 between DeKalb County (County), Archer Western (Contractor) and Tetra Tech, the County is hereby directing Tetra Tech to allow the incorporation of the previously submitted thirty-three (33) Time Impact Analysis (TIAs) into the Overall Progress Schedule (a.k.a. the "working schedule"). It is understood that five (5) of the TIA's have been reviewed by Tetra Tech and have been deemed eligible for a Contract Time extension totaling 210 days, two (2) of the TIA's will impact the Dewatering Building Interim Milestone Date, while the remaining twenty-six (26) TIA's will have no impact on the critical path or Contract Milestone Dates.

To ensure that the Overall Progress Schedule accurately represents the Work, the County hereby requests that Tetra Tech analyze and include all documented time impacts. This shall include impacts that both do, and do not, affect the construction completion milestone dates or critical path, including delay events caused by the Contractor as documented in Non-Compliance Notices and Quality Incident Reports. It should be noted that this written authorization does not authorize the Contractor or Tetra Tech to revise the Contract Milestone Dates, Contract Time, or Contract Term, which can only be altered by DeKalb County's Governing Authority.

The County recognizes the increased level of effort that will be required for Tetra Tech to manage the Overall Progress Schedule in the directed manner and understands this effort may exceed Tetra Tech's current scope of work. As such, it is requested that Tetra Tech include an estimate of the schedule management costs in a forthcoming
