## Christopher Robinson:

Pittman, EL Jones- Subcontractor and GDOT have counted a "revised" number of 140 total Manholes requiring adjustments by both lowering and raising to final elevation. This is an increase of 88 manholes. Pittman is proposing to add a pay item Extra Work: Traffic Control for manhole per each. Creating a pay item in this manner for all manhole adjustments beyond the original scope will protect both parties from either over/underrun of quantities, resulting in payment for only work that is performed.

Lane Closures are based on 88 manhole increase

Lowering 3 / night: 88/3 = 30 nights Rising 2 / night: 88/2 = 44 nights

Total nights= 74 nights

Lane closures for 74 nights at \$ 1,200/ night =	\$ 88,800.00
Police (1) to cover the 74 nights at \$ 800.00/ night =	\$ 59,200.00
Total additional Traffic Control Lane Closures =	\$ 148,000.00
Profit (10%)=	\$ 14,800.00
Overhead (10%)=	\$ 14,800.00
Bond (1%)=	\$ 1,776.00
Total costs of Traffic Control=	\$ 179,376.00

\$ 179,376.00 / 88 manholes = \$ 2,038.35/EA
