Proposed Amendment/Change Order No. 3 to DeKalb County ITB No. 17-

100898 for Asphaltic Pavement Repair Services

Original Contract Term and Dollar Amount: June 12, 2018 through June 30, 2021 and \$24,466,057.22

Previous Changes to the Dollar Amount: Change Order No. 1 added \$500,000 and Change Order No. 2 added \$8,833,846.11

Previous Changes to the Term: None

Current Cumulative Contract Term and Dollar Amount: Ends June 30, 2021 and \$33,799,903.33

Proposed Contract Term and Dollar Amount: Additional funding for \$1,200,000.00

Detailed Description of Requested Changes: We are requesting to add \$400,000.00 to each vendor and to extend contract term through December 31,2021. This proposed funding request will enable our current contractors to continue providing asphaltic pavement repair services for our Public Works – Roads & Drainage roadway (patching) repair projects and Surety Bond Streets.

Justification for the Proposed Changes and an Explanation of why the County should not consider a Competitive Bid: We currently have three contractors active that are responsive to ITB No. 17-100898 for these asphalt patching services. With the proposed funding and contract extension this gives the County more time to complete more roadway projects, while we reestablish a new solicitation for a new contract through our Purchasing & Contracting Department.
