PURPOSE:

The Recreation, Parks and Cultural Affairs Department seeks Board of Commissioner approval to rename Rehoboth Park to Pea Ridge Park.

NEED/IMPACT:

At the request of the surrounding community, RPCA seeks approval to rename the DeKalb County park located at 3105 Tolbert Drive, Decatur, GA 30033 from Rehoboth Park to Pea Ridge Park.
