NEED/IMPACT:

The attached multi-project Memorandum of Understanding governs the use of supplies and equipment provided

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by UASI to assist the DeKalb County Police, DeKalb County Fire Rescue, and the DeKalb Emergency Management Departments in preventing, protecting, responding to, and recovering from threats or acts of terrorism and to build capabilities that enhance homeland security for the Atlanta metropolitan area.
