PURPOSE:

To consider adopting the attached resolution consenting to the deannexation from the City of Clarkston property located at 1078 Nielsen Drive.

To consider authorizing all of the property become a part of unincorporated DeKalb County upon approval of the deannexation ordinance by the City of Clarkston; and

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary documents.

NEED/IMPACT:

The owner of 1086 Nielsen Drive desires that the property be deannexed from Clarkston into unincorporated DeKalb County. O.C.G.A. Section 36-36-22 requires owners of land who desire deannexation to submit a written signed application containing a complete description of the property to the city where the property lies and further requires that the county consent to such deannexation. Consent shall be indicated in a resolution. If

the attached resolution consenting to the deannexation is adopted, the owners will then apply with the City of Clarkston for deannexation via ordinance.

The County Attorney's Office has reviewed the attached resolution and approved it as-to-form.

FISCAL IMPACT:
