### **PURPOSE:**

1. To consider approval of transferring \$250,000 Fiscal Year 18 Dislocated Worker program funds to Fiscal Year 18 Adult funds.

2. To consider authorizing the funds when appropriate; and

3. To consider authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute the necessary document.

### NEED/IMPACT:

Worksource DeKalb can serve more individuals with Adult funds as opposed to Dislocated Workers. The unemployment rate of DeKalb County as well as the State is 3.3% and 3.7%, respectively and is at an all-time low therefore, there are less dislocated workers to serve in the county.
