NEED/IMPACT:

In the County's Mid-Year 2019 Budget, \$250,000 was approved by the Board of Commissioners for a county-wide Recreation, Parks and Cultural Affairs 10-year Master Plan. RPCA is requesting the \$250,000 be transferred to a CIP project account. The anticipated completion date of the plan is mid-2020.
