PURPOSE:

To consider accepting \$22,725.00 for DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court from the Criminal
Justice
Coordinating Council (CJCC) and appropriating the amount to an existing grant award.

NEED/IMPACT:

The Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC) has awarded \$22,725.00 to the DeKalb County
Felony
Mental Health Court to use towards a dedicated treatment provider to facilitate groups for Program
Coordinator. This would ensure that the coordinator and treatment provider are not the same individual per the
request of Council of Accountability Court Judges (CACJ). The funding period is from April 1, 2021 to June
30, 2021 and no match is required.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for a dedicated treatment provider to facilitate groups for Program Coordinator is provided by Criminal Justice Coordinating Council in the amount of \$22,725.00. Funding must be expended by June 30, 2021, end of State FY 2021.

RECOMMENDATION:

To approve the resolution and authorize the chief executive officer to execute all necessary documents. To accept \$22,725.00 for DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and appropriate the amount to an existing grant award.
