**PURPOSE:**

To transfer \$35,000 from District 4 Parks Bond Account for installation of a pavilion a capital improvement project at Wade Walker Park.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

The funds are needed for capital improvement project at Wade Walker Park. This includes the installation of a pavilion for guest of the park. The Pavilion will be an added amenity for constituents visiting the park. Wade Walker Park netball and tennis players are extremely active but lack a covered rest area. A pavilion would provide shade and protection from inclement weather as well as encourage folks to picnic, watch, and perhaps participate in sport activities.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommend that funds in the amount of \$35,000 be transferred from 2001 Parks Bond District 4 account for
