**PURPOSE:**

To consider authorizing the payment to Georgia Power of up to \$13,000.00 for changes to existing street lights for construction of the Lithonia Industrial Boulevard Extension project from I-20 to Woodrow Road; and To consider authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute all necessary documents pertaining to this project.

**NEED/IMPACT:**

The extension of Lithonia Industrial Boulevard from I-20 will require the removal of three existing street lights and the adjustment of three others that are along county-owned and privately-owned sections of Woodrow Road.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Existing HOST and CIP funds for the project will be used to pay for this work.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

To authorize the payment to Georgia Power of up to \$13,000.00 for changes to existing street lights for construction of the Lithonia Industrial Boulevard Extension project from I-20 to Woodrow Road; and
